WHAT WILL YOU DO WITH GOD'S GRACE?

"For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men" (Titus 2:11). God's grace has appeared to you. What will you do with it? Grace can be:

FOUND. "But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord" (Gen. 6:8). Hebrews 4:16 says, "Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need."

SEEN. "Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord" (Acts 11:23).

KNOWN. "For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel; which is come unto you, as it is in all the world; and bringeth forth fruit, as it doth also in you, since the day ye heard of it, and knew the grace of God in truth" (Col. 1:5-6). Grace comes "through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord" (2 Pet. 1:2).

ACCESSED. Paul wrote, "By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein

we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God" (Rom. 5:2). Faith comes by hearing the word of God (Rom. 10:17).

CONTINUED IN. "Now when the congregation was broken up, many of the Jews and religious proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas: who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in the grace of God" (Acts 13:43).

RECEIVED IN VAIN. "We then, as workers together with him, beseech you also that ye receive not the grace of God in vain" (2 Cor. 6:1).

FALLEN FROM. Paul told the Galatians, "Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace" (Gal. 5:4). We must "give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall" (2 Pet. 1:10).

TURNED INTO

LASCIVIOUSNESS. Jude wrote of "certain men" who were "turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ" (Jude 4).

FAILED OF. "Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many

be defiled" (Heb. 12:15). We must look diligently so we don't fall short of the grace of God!

LEARNED FROM. Did you know grace teaches? Paul told Titus concerning the grace of God, "Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in this present world; looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ" (Titus 2:12-13).

GROWN IN. Peter penned, "But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ" (2 Pet. 3:18). Are you growing? We are to "be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus" (2 Tim. 2:1).

OBTAINED IN CHRIST.

"And the grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in Christ Jesus" (1 Tim. 1:14). "Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus" (2 Tim. 2:1). Are you in Christ?

OF A TRUTH

The expression, "of a truth" is found 18 times in the King James. It simply means: truly, in reality, most certainly. Let's take a look.

JESUS IS THE SON OF GOD. At the wind-ceasing, seacalming scene of Matthew 14, "...they that were in the ship came and worshipped him [Jesus], saying, Of a truth thou art the Son of God" (v. 33). At the death of Jesus on the cross of Calvary, the centurion said, "Truly this was the Son of God" (Mt. 27:54). We have everything needed in the written record to "...believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God..." (Jn. 20:30-31). Do you believe this truth? Have you confessed your faith in the Son of God? "For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation" (Rom.

THE KINGDOM HAS

10:10).

COME. Jesus declared, "But I tell you of a truth, there be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the

kingdom of God" (Lk. 9:27). The kingdom of God most certainly came within their lifetime. The kingdom was to come with power (Mk. 9:1). Power was to come after the Holy Spirit came upon the apostles (Acts 1:8). The Holy Spirit came upon the apostles on Pentecost (Acts 2:1-4). Thus, the kingdom came on Pentecost in Acts 2, in the lifetime of some of the disciples standing there as Jesus said. The Colossians were translated into it (Col. 1:13), John was in it (Rev. 1:9) and so can we be!

GAVE ALL. As Jesus observed treasury-giving, He stated: "Of a truth I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they all" (Lk. 21:3). The rich gave "of their abundance", but she "all that she had". This is about sacrifice! David said, "...neither will I offer burnt offerings unto the Lord my God of that which doth cost me nothing" (2 Sam. 24:24). What

truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: But in every nation he that feareth him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with him" (Acts 10:34-35). This one statement defeats the false teachings of Calvinism. Paul penned, "For there is no respect of persons with God" (Rom. 2:11). God "...will have all to be saved..." (1 Tim. 2:3-4) and is "...not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance" (2 Pet. 3:9).

Will you come to repentance and be saved?
