Exodus 20:12, “Honour thy father and thy **mother**: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.”

Exodus 21:15, “And he that smiteth his father, or his **mother**, shall be surely put to death.”

Exodus 21:17, “And he that curseth his father, or his **mother**, shall surely be put to death.”

Leviticus 19:3, “Ye shall fear every man his **mother**, and his father...I am the Lord your God.”

Leviticus 20:9, “For every one that curseth his father or his **mother** shall be surely put to death: he hath cursed his father or his mother; his blood shall be upon him.”

Deuteronomy 5:16, “Honour thy father and thy **mother**, as the Lord thy God hath commanded thee: that thy days may be prolonged, and that it may go well with thee, in the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.”

Deuteronomy 21:18-21, “If a man have a stubborn and rebellious son, which will not

obey the voice of his father, or the voice of his **mother**, and that, when they have chastened him, will not hearken unto them: Then shall his father and his **mother** lay hold on him, and bring him out unto the elders of his city, and unto the gate of his place; And they shall say unto the elders of his city, This our son is stubborn and rebellious, he will not obey our voice; he is a glutton, and a drunkard. And all the men of his city shall stone him with stones, that he die: so shalt thou put evil away from among you; and all Israel shall hear, and fear.”

Proverbs 1:8-9, “My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy **mother**: For they shall be an ornament of grace unto thy head, and chains about thy neck.”

Proverbs 6:20-22, “My son, keep thy father’s commandment, and forsake not the law of thy **mother**: Bind them continually upon thine heart, and tie them about thy neck. When thou goest, it shall lead thee; when thou sleepest, it shall keep thee; and when thou awakest, it shall talk with thee.”

Proverbs 10:1, “...A wise son maketh a glad father: but a

foolish son is the heaviness of his **mother**.”

Proverbs 15:20, “A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish man despiseth his **mother**.”

Proverbs 19:26, “He that wasteth his father, and chaseth away his **mother**, is a son that causeth shame, and bringeth reproach.”

Proverbs 20:20, “Whoso curseth his father or his **mother**, his lamp shall be put out in obscure darkness.”

Proverbs 23:22, “Hearken unto thy father that begat thee, and despise not thy **mother** when she is old.”

Proverbs 28:24, “Whoso robbeth his father or his **mother**, and saith, It is no transgression; the same is the companion of a destroyer.”

Proverbs 30:11, “There is a generation that curseth their father, and doth not bless their **mother**.”

Proverbs 30:17, “The eye that mocketh at his father, and despiseth to obey his **mother**, the ravens of the valley shall pick it out, and the young eagles

shall eat it.”


